

## I ORDERED A PRIVATE PONTOON

### WHAT I CAN DO



Only light furniture (less than 70kg: parasol, reception desk, post, plants, etc.)

I order my business tivoli and my railings from the organization:

- see the order form for additional fittings for outdoor stands,
- railings on quotation only,
- CAUTION, the organisers reserve the right to refuse an order for a tivoli depending on the surrounding layout (see technical regulations -> 1.Building rules (Vieux Port & Port Canto) -> . Pontoons.)



Business Tivoli

**(Dimensions: 3m x 2.5m)**

- Parasols

Parasols are allowed under the following conditions:

- The area covered by the parasol must not exceed 50% of the total surface area of the stand.
- The parasol must be properly weighted (a certification from a Control Bureau is required).
- The open parasol must not encroach on the aisle.
- Parasols must be spaced apart; the use of zips to connect them is prohibited.
- It is mandatory to close the parasols every evening and in case of wind during the day.

### WHAT I CANNOT DO



NO CONSTRUCTION ON PONTOON

Are also prohibited:

- partitions,
- other non-approved structures such as pergolas,
- totems,
- flags more than 2m high,
- heavy furniture (more than 70kg).
